

## MIDLAND COUNTY CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES For 2010 - 2011

Each year, the Midland County Educational Service Agency in partnership with Bullock Creek School District, Coleman Community Schools, Meridian Schools and Midland Public Schools, offers Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs at different sites throughout the county. These programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment and advanced training/educational opportunities and are offered under the guidance of certified instructors, counselors, and administrators.

The following state-approved CTE programs are available to high school students in Midland County for the 2010-2011 school year:

Accounting/Finance & Financial Management	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Career interest in accounting or financial management.	Bullock Creek Midland Public Schools
Automotive Technology	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Career interest in automotive technology and mechanics. Program follows national automotive curriculum standards.	Midland Public Schools
Building Construction Trades	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Career interest in various construction trades such as carpentry, electricity and masonry. Focus on residential construction with students building a house.	Bullock Creek Midland Public Schools
Business Administration, Management & Operations	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Interest in careers related to business. Focus given to learning all Microsoft Office applications.	Bullock Creek Coleman Schools Midland Public Schools
Certified Nursing Assistant Training	12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 11 <sup>th</sup> grade) Interest in nursing careers. Preparation to take the state exam for CNA. Ability to complete clinical experience which includes completion of a background check and various health requirements.	Midland County ESA
Chemical Processing Technology	12 <sup>th</sup> grade Interest in a career as a chemical process operator. Eligibility for dual enrollment. Completion of Algebra 2 and Physics is required.	Midland County ESA
Computer Aided Design (CAD)	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Career interest in CAD, design or engineering. Basic computer skills are recommended.	Midland Public Schools
Cosmetology	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade Interest in cosmetology as a career. Course provides knowledge, skills, and clinical hours toward preparation for state certification exam.	Midland County ESA
Digital Multimedia and Information Resource Design	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Interest in web design and other aspects of multimedia design. Basic computer skills are recommended.	Midland Public Schools
Family & Consumer Science	9 <sup>th</sup> - 12 <sup>th</sup> grade Courses include parenthood, human development, food & nutrition, personal living and designing for career & family.	Midland Public Schools
Health Care Technology	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade Interest in healthcare career. Ability to complete clinical experience which includes completion of a background check and various health requirements.	Midland Public Schools
Hospitality & Tourism	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade Interest in hotel/restaurant management or culinary arts. National ProStart curriculum is followed in this program.	Midland County ESA

Information Technology	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade Eligibility for dual enrollment. Basic computer skills needed. Career interest in IT industry. Focus given to functionality of hardware and software with preparation for certifications such as A+ and Security +.	Midland County ESA
Marketing, Sales & Service, and Entrepreneurship	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Career interest in marketing, sales or entrepreneurship.	Midland Public Schools
Welding Technology	11 <sup>th</sup> or 12 <sup>th</sup> grade (selectively open to 10 <sup>th</sup> grade) Interest in welding as a career. Program gives focus to American Welding Society standards.	Midland Public Schools
